Dear Friends.

As I write this there is a warning of snow and ice in the next few days. The winter weather is here! But, looking forward to February 13th, that is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent and hopefully, better weather. All through the year we read and hear the words of Holy Scripture, some passages are so well known, some are unfamiliar. They tell the great story of God's love for his people. The Bible is full of wonderful characters, travellers and pilgrims, refugees, kings and priests, rogues and victims, holy men and women, historians, poets, prophets and letter writers. Our Gospel writers tell us the story of Jesus, recording his life, death, resurrection and ascension. We can read Jesus own words and stories, see the effect he had on the people around him, and then, how the Disciples became the Apostles who taught the world about Jesus redeeming love. The Scriptures teach us so many things, and, although they were written so long ago, they still have a great relevance for us. St Paul reminds us that: "For whatsoever was written in former days was written for our instruction, so that by steadfastness and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope."

This Lent, let us take down our Bibles and read the words that inspire and teach us. We might find new meaning in the passages we love so well. We might come across passages that are less familiar, a psalm we have never read before, one of St Paul's letters, chapters from the Book of Revelation. We might see reflections of our troubled times in the history books of the Old Testament. And most wonderfully, we can read again the story of God's Word becoming flesh in the person of Jesus. It is customary to give something up as an act of penitence during Lent, perhaps we can also decide to read more from our Bibles every day, discovering there, in those ancient texts, reassurance of God's mercy and grace and redemption and forgiveness in the person of God's son, Jesus.

Almighty God, we thank you for the gift of your Holy Word. May it be a lantern to our feet, a light to our paths, And a strength to our lives.

Take us and use us to love and serve all people,
In the power of the Holy Spirit, and the name of your Son,
Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.




