St Michael's Church Dear Friends,

On July 31st we shall have a Confirmation Service in St Mary the Virgin church, Marden, at 3.30pm. There is a good number of candidates from across our Group of Parishes. The Confirmation Service is very special to the candidates as it is a time when they stand before God and his people to affirm their faith and their commitment to the church. We all remember our Confirmation services and the excitement of taking Holy Communion for the very first time. As we look forward to this important service in the life of our Parishes, let us pray for the candidates, and remember how we came to be confirmed, all those people who taught us and guided us in the way of Christ, and how we have answered God's call to us in our lives and in our prayers.

For all that God can do within us, for all that God can do without us, Thanks be to God.

For all in whom Christ lived before us, for all in whom Christ lives beside us, Thanks be to God.

For all the Spirit wants to bring us, for where the Spirit wants to send us, Thanks be to God.

Christ has promised to be with us, in the world and in our worship.

PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

The Council did not meet this month. However, normal business continues: we have arranged for the drains to be jetted in Bowley lane and have job numbers from Amey for renewing the painting on the roads in Ketch Lane and Bowley Lane. We are proceeding with the purchase of a new waste bin to be located at the Bus Shelter by Chapel Lane. We are also progressing the outstanding issues regarding the HGV traffic in Chapel Lane and the dog mess in Ketch lane.

You will all now have seen the Speed Indicator Device (SID) located at various points in the village. We have collated excellent detailed information which will enable the local police to carry out spot checks at key times and locations. Sadly the information shows that over 50% of all vehicles are speeding and the highest speed recorded is 82mph!

The SID was purchased in order to assist with reducing speed and making Bodenham roads safe. It is not our intention for people to be fined but the council is committed to reducing speed and the Police will be working during the next few months by carrying out spot checks. Derek Ling

COMMUNITY LED PLAN

We have now received the detailed analysis of the questionnaires which were completed last year. We had an excellent response from the Community and now have some real information about what matters to you all. The Steering group will be analysing the data, setting priorities and a developing an action plan. During the next few months we will publish some of the data and give you feedback on our progress.

DINMORE SPOUT

The Parish Council has been notified by the Scientific Officer in the Environmental Health and Trading Standards department at Herefordshire Council that the water at the spring serving Dinmore Spout is not fit to drink. For the scientifically minded, it was found that there are 118 mpn (mean probable number) of coliforms and 8 mpn of clostridia perfringens per 100ml of water. For each of these bacteria the safe limit is zero per 100ml! Coliforms do not normally cause serious illness, but clostridia perfringens is the third most common cause of food poisoning in the UK. You have been warned.

PLANNING APPLICATIONS

Brockington Golf Club: amendment to design of approved holiday lodges. This application has been refused by Herefordshire Council on the grounds that "the proposed amendments to the previously approved scheme are of a scale and design which would be imposing on the appearance of the area and would have an adverse effect on the overall character of the landscape". (The amendment was to increase the height of the lodges from one storey to two).

Dalarma, Church Walk: replacement garage with hobbies room/store. Herefordshire Council have granted planning permission for this application. Moor Court Farm: proposed agricultural building extension. Herefordshire Council have advised that prior approval is not required for this application.

Richland Farm, Ullingswick: installation of photovoltaic panels on an agricultural building. Herefordshire Council have granted planning permission for this application.

15 Ashgrove View: installation of two Velux windows in garage roof. Herefordshire Council have granted planning permission for this application.

Bus services - possible reduction. Herefordshire Council has started a public consultation on bus services, which runs until 17th July. Tenders for bus services are due for renewal later this year and, if sufficient savings cannot be made elsewhere, then it is very possible that services will have to be reduced. The Parish Council has been asked to respond as part of the review, but members of the public are also encouraged to do so, by completing an online questionnaire, which can be found at www.herefordbus.info . Full details of the public consultation have been placed on the Parish Council noticeboards.

The next Parish Council meeting will be held at 7.30pm on Monday 4th July at the Siward James Centre. Copies of the agenda are placed on parish notice boards in advance and everyone is most welcome to attend and raise any matters of concern during the slot reserved for this purpose during the meeting. Bus Service Update

As you may know, all the bus services are being reviewed this summer, with a public consultation taking place until 15th July. Judging by the number of people (418) who have signed the recently circulated petition, I know that there is considerable support for our 426 route, and I hope many of you will feel encouraged to express your support by completing the consultation form. Further details are available through following a link on the Council website www.herefordshire.gov.uk. From here the consultation form can be filled in on line or printed off and sent in by Freepost. Copies will also be available in public places.

I have written to the new Cabinet Member for Highways and Transportation (Cllr. Blackshaw), and our new Councillor (Cllr Millar) expressing some thoughts about our bus service. Here is an extract:

"As a resident of Bodenham I am writing to you in praise of our bus service, and to let you know just how important it is to us...... I know that many of my fellow residents in Bodenham and elsewhere along the 426 route agree because I have in my possession 21 sheets of petitions with a total of 418 signatures expressing their support of the campaign to save Herefordshire bus services."

Our bus service is valuable for so many reasons:

- As an independent lifeline for those who do not have cars or are unable to drive, including the elderly, those with disabilities, those unable to afford a car, and the young travelling to and from college or school.
- So that those who do drive can reduce car dependency. The introduction of concessionary travel has {shown} that there are alternatives to simply getting in the car for every journey; {and} the increasing high cost of fuel has encouraged many to think again before automatically using their cars. It would be a pity if this boost for the use of public transport was diminished.
- To enable easier access to national travel including rail and coach services. It is a great advantage that journeys can be taken by rail knowing that there are bus services into and out of Hereford.
- Environmental benefits are achieved by reducing the number of car journeys. Reducing the high levels of congestion and pollution, so the more people who travel in by bus the better.
- Economic benefits to Herefordshire are achieved by encouraging people to take the bus into town to shop, visit restaurants etc, rather than use their cars and possibly go out of the County. The frequency of the present service into Hereford allows for this.

Thanks to you all who have signed the petitions. They have now been delivered to Councillor Blackshaw's office. The Council is looking for feedback and suggestions about bus services so I hope you will feel inclined to respond positively. Steve Lavender


