St Michael & All Angels' Church Bodenham Dear Friends,

In November we remember the conflicts and wars of our age and ages past. This year, Remembrance Sunday falls on November 11th and at the 11 th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month the whole nation will pause to remember the sacrifice made by men and women of previous generations and still being made today.

Wilfred Owen is one of the most famous soldiers of World War One, his poetry is still read and studied, and is as relevant today as it was in the days of the Great War. He wrote the following letter to his mother, and the events he describes are typical of that War. Men and women still go into battle, and in spite of the changes in weapons and tactics they do share a common experience with Wilfred Owen.

As we remember and pray for all those who have given their lives for our freedom, or have been injured and disabled in war, let us also remember and pray for our servicemen and women today who work to defend us, and as we pray for them, let us pray for peace and justice, for reconciliation and resurrection in countries that have seen so much war and sorrow.

25 April 1917 A Coy., My Cellar My own dearest Mother,

Immediately after I sent my last letter, more than a fortnight ago, we were rushed up into the Line. Twice in one day we went over the top, gaining both our objectives. Our A Company led the Attack, and of course lost a certain number of men. I had some extraordinary escapes from shells & bullets. Fortunately there was no bayonet work, since the Hun ran before we got up to his trench. You will find mention of our fight in the Communiqué; the place happens to be the very village which Father named in his last letter! Never before has the Battalion encountered such intense shelling as rained on us as we advanced in the open.

The Colonel sent round this message the next day: 'I was filled with admiration at the conduct of the Battalion under the heavy shell-fire.... The leadership of officers was excellent, and the conduct of the men beyond praise.' The reward we got for all this was to remain in the Line 12 days.

For twelve days I did not wash my face, nor take off my boots, nor sleep a deep sleep. For twelve days we lay in holes, where at any moment a shell might put us out. I think the worst incident was one wet night when we lay up against a railway embankment. A big shell lit on the top of the bank, just 2 yards from my head. Before I awoke, I was blown in the air right away from the bank! I passed most of the following days in a railway Cutting, in a hole just big enough to lie in, and covered with corrugated iron. My brother officer of B Coy., 2/Lt. Gaukroger lay opposite in a similar hole. But he was covered with earth, and no relief will ever relieve him, nor will his Rest be a 9 days' Rest. (Remainder missing)

VISIT TO ENVIROSORT......

Cllrs Roger Austin and Jeff Pollard and Chris Smith, the Parish Clerk, visited EnviroSort's recycling plant near Worcester, where all the rubbish from your wheelie bin ends up. The visit was arranged by Cllr Jeremy Millar, District Councillor for the Hampton Court ward, which includes Bodenham. The enormous plant – which has 1 kilometre of conveyor belts - handles 350 tons of waste from Hereford each week, as well as waste from Worcester, Malvern and surrounding areas. 94% is recycled, including 120 large bales of waste paper every day. Most of the waste is mechanically separated, but the separator can't tell the difference between a flat tin and a newspaper, so please do not crush tins. Two other 'don't's' are: do not leave tops on bottles and do not put low-energy light bulbs in your wheelie bin. Take them to a recycling centre.

MANY THANKS

to everyone who participated in the LITTER PICK held on Saturday 13th October. 15 bags of rubbish were collected, plus a couple of tyres. Thanks are due also to Amey, who provided the litter pick equipment and collected the bags, and especially to Babs Mitcheson for providing the soup and rolls for the weary pickers.

to the residents on the C1125 who have cut back hedges to make it safer to walk along the pavements and easier to see the bus approaching.

Where is Smeadal Lane in Bodenham?

Indeed, is there a Smeadal Lane in Bodenham? I ask for two reasons. Firstly, I reported some fly-tipping in 'Smeadal Lane' to Amey, who replied that they didn't know where Smeadal Lane was: it was not on any of their maps.

Secondly, a long-time resident (70 years plus) talked unasked about Dunfield Lane running from the C1125 near The Old Police House to Millcroft Road, with a 90 degree right turn more or less opposite the electricity substation. He had never heard of Smeadal Lane. So, does Smeadal Lane exist?

Well, the 1813 field map of Bodenham shows a field called Smeddall Mow alongside the road from the substation to Millcroft Road, but most of that road is bounded by a large field called Dun Field, as is the rest of Dunfield Lane, suggesting that the whole stretch really is Dunfield Lane.
