Dear Friends.

Afraid, alone, in pain.

Be the answer to Loko's prayer this Christian Aid Week.

This Christian Aid Week, you can help transform the lives of women like Loko. From 10-16 May, churches the length and breadth of Britain and Ireland will come together to pray, campaign and raise money to improve the lives of people like Loko.

Every year, 100,000 volunteers demonstrate God's love for the poor by taking part in house-tohouse collections for Christian Aid. This fantastic witness is a chance to take the mission of the church into your community.

Loko's choice in life is simple: 'If I can't collect firewood, my children will die.'

Four times a week, in a remote corner of Ethiopia, Loko makes a back-breaking eight-hour trip to gather wood. It's a task she dreads, but she steels herself to do it because if she doesn't her children will starve. She prays to God as she walks. 'I ask him to change my life and lead us out of this,' she says.

Just £5 could give Loko a loan to start her own business buying and selling tea and coffee, freeing her from her desperate task and allowing her to spend more time caring for her family.

Christian Aid works with a partner organisation in Ethiopia, called HUNDEE. This organisation was established in 1995, HUNDEE is a local non-governmental organization based on the philosophy that poor rural communities should be responsible for their own development. HUNDEE acts as a facilitator in this process. HUNDEE's major programs include community organizing, cereal bank promotion and networks, community education, environmental rehabilitation, and women's and older persons' economic support.

HUNDEE's mission is to enable small farmers, women, older persons, youth and other marginalized groups to get organized around common issues of concern for livelihoods, and to revitalize proven community based traditional support system & institutions; to reduce vulnerability of target groups to transitory food shortage, to enable target groups to rehabilitate their degraded land; to empower women to attain economic and social rights, and eradicate all forms of violence and discrimination against them. By supporting Christian Aid we support the work of partner organisations that work to encourage and help women like Loko.

Great God, our creator, who challenges injustice from a wooden cross, kindle in us that same passion for justice that inspires Christian Aid's partner HUNDEE. Strengthen, we pray, the hundreds of Lokos gathering the firewood of survival. Spark, in Loko, the flame of your hope that it may burn brightly in Ethiopia, in Britain and Ireland and throughout this, the world that you have created.

However, there will be an election for the Hampton Court Ward to replace Councillor Jeremy Millar, who is standing down.

The candidates, in alphabetical order, are: Bruce Baker (Conservative), Sasha Norris (It's Our County) and Angela Verley (unattached).

Potholes

The Parish Lengthsman can now fill smaller potholes. The procedure for arranging for the Lengths man to fill potholes is rather complicated. In the first instance, please report the pothole to the Parish Clerk at 01568-797132 or bodenhampcclerk@gmail.com . He will then arrange for the Locality Steward and the Lengthsman to inspect the pothole together. They will decide whether the size of the pothole is such that the Lengthsman can repair it or whether it needs Balfour Beatty's specialist team to do the job.

Planning applications

The Parish Council considered the following planning application:

* 150871: Ashgrove Croft, Marden. Variation of conditions to allow for the siting of an additional 4 static and 4 touring caravans and an ablution block (instead of the permitted

and an ablution block (instead of the permitted stable block). The Parish Council raised a number of concerns about this application, which will be passed on to Herefordshire Council. Because the site lies in Marden, Marden Parish Council will be expected to take the lead on responses to the application.

These letters have not come from The Marches GP Practice, which offers a full prescription service at the Bodenham Surgery.
