DEFIBRILLATOR

The Parish Council is exploring the possibility of acquiring a defibrillator, which could save lives, because an ambulance cannot reach Bodenham within the 8 minute period crucial for survival from a heart attack. It has been suggested that the defibrillator could be located outside the parish hall.

PLANNING APPLICATIONS

- * Brook House: Demolish and rebuild rear extension. Approved.
- * Land adjacent to Stoneleigh: outline application for site for residential development. Refused.

Herefordshire Council have made the following decisions:

* Maund Court: demolition and rebuild of poultry house. Approved with conditions.

* Land adjacent to Hill View: erection of agricultural worker's dwelling with garage and new vehicular access. Refused.
