

## St Michael's CE Primary School News

Tanzania Link: Mrs. Alty is obviously back safely with us from her travels to our link school in Tengeru, Tanzania. She had a fantastic time working with the staff and children over there, and she was able to deliver the money that we raised to give to the school. She tells us that the £150 that we raised together is equivalent to three months of the entire school budget—this is a small illustration of the tiny amount of funding and resources that a school of around 800 children receives in Tanzania.

Mrs Alty has lots to tell the children, and she has already started to do this during Assembly times. She was also able to deliver letters from Tanzanian pupils that were in reply to letters from us that she had taken over with her. 
