## BACHE'S BARGAINS.....

....... have kindly agreed to open their gates on Mondays (their closing day) and not to cone off the entrance, so that customers of the post office and the hairdressers can park in Bache's car park. As a result, the entrance will be in constant use, so please do not park in any way which blocks the entrance - in particular not in the hatched area

### ROAD SAFETY

Bodenham Parish Council is continually reviewing road safety issues in Bodenham as a result of feedback from the Parish Plan (copies of which are still available from the parish clerk). One possible improvement is to install speed reduction and other safety measures around the post office. Any progress in this matter will be reported in the Newsletter.

## THE BUS SHELTER.....

........... opposite Englands Gate has a short path between it an the road, but the bus shelter at Chapel Lane does not have a path. Accordingly, Bodenham Parish Council is exploring the possibility of installing a path at the Chapel Lane bus shelter. Any progress in this matter will be reported in the Newsletter.

## THERE IS NO FOOTPATH.....

....... between Ashgrove Road and Millcroft Road, and there is no room to install one, even if there was finance to do so. Walking along the road through Bodenham Moor between these points, therefore, is hazardous and dangerous. An alternative route - along Brockington Road past the surgery - is much safer and only a little longer. It may even be shorter for some people.

## RESUSCITATION TRAINING






