MINUTES OF MEETING 12th **SEPTEMBER:** These had been circulated prior to this meeting were approved by all and signed by the Chairman.

MATTERS ARISING: There were none.

TREASURER'S REPORT: B. Clarke reported we have £7,300 in the bank with no bills outstanding. Money is in reserve for the replacement of the Boiler Room door and the Tennis Club window. The Gold Account has been closed. There is an outstanding hiring charge of £342 and a reminder has been sent to the Tai Chi hirer. Last year's figures will be forwarded to the Charity Commission.

HALL POLICIES: Following a meeting with G. & B. Bowden, R. Knott had e-mailed three documents to all committee members for consideration. R. Knott is, at present, dealing with a policy relating to Money Laundering. A discussion took place on each policy and, subject to minor alterations, all the committee agreed to these policies.

FLICKS IN THE STICKS: J. Stephens reported that at the showing in October only 17 persons had attended. The next film on the 9th November is "The Darkest Hour" with "The Greatest Showman" on the 14th December. It had been decided not to show the film "Edie" as a Borderline event but will be shown at a Flicks in the Sticks evening.

PARISH HALL MAINTENANCE: G. Bowden had instructed Tom Dines (Electrician) to check on one of the outside lights; to carry out PAT testing required and to quote for a new hand dryer in the kitchen.

Secretary's Postscript – Following an inspection of the heating programme with G. Bowden and R. Knott, Tom had not been able to solve the question "can we move the heating programmer into the Boiler Room". This question arose because, as last winter, someone is turning the heating Off altogether and G. Bowden is tired of having to come and check if the heating is on, (most times it is Off). She has taped up and put a suitable notice on the programmer and hopes that this will act as a deterrent.
