Schedule of work for the Parish Lengthsman

The regular duties of the Parish Lengthsman are:

- Strimming of grass verges on road junction (A417/C1125)
- Strimming around bus shelter and strimming of grass verge opposite (C1125)
- Strimming of grass opposite Saffrons Cross Garage
- Strimming around second bus shelter in village (C1125)
- Strimming of grass verge at T-junction (C1125/Chapel Lane)
- Strimming of grass verges on T-junction (U94018/C1125)
- Strimming of grass verges along road and under white railings by bridge on both sides of the road (U94020)
- Strimming of grass verges on junction (U94020/Chapel Lane)
- Strimming grass verges along the stream in Millcroft Road
- Strimming around the bases for the SID
- Strimming verges on C1125 in late summer, if necessary
- Clearing out drains and ditches (as appropriate)
- Cutting back overhanging branches from around road signs and junctions
- Keeping hedges tidy on C1121 before and beyond the war memorial
- Cleaning road signs
- Keeping grips clear
- Spraying weeds in gutters
- Keeping the playground tidy (e.g. raking chippings, removing litter, replacing palings)
- Make regular visits to Holbatch Lane

Lengthsman also have a general responsibility to:

- Report potholes
- Remove litter
- Carry out any other nominated tasks
