PARISH COUNCIL NEWS CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

The Council have met in July and August and I am very pleased to confirm that we have

co-opted new members to the Council and are now at full strength. The new members are Katy Wrathall, Rhiannon Powell, Tony Mitcheson, Dennis Jackson, Bob Clarke and Jeff Pollard.

At the August meeting we invited the Joint Masters of the North Hereford Hunt to attend and discuss the issues which have been highlighted recently regarding dog mess and noise. Members of the public were given an opportunity to raise their concerns and I hope you can see that the situation has improved. The Hunt are holding an 'Open Afternoon' from 3.00pm to 5.00pm on 4th September when local people can visit the kennels and understand more about its day to day activities.

The Council has also set up a sub-group to advise on planning matters and this will consist of three councillors, Pam James-Moore, Katy Wrathall and Bob Clarke. Meanwhile, Dennis Jackson will represent the Council on the Parish Hall Committee and Tony Mitcheson will represent the Council on the Bodenham Flood Protection Group. Derek Ling, Chairman

FOOTPATH EXTINGUISHMENT AND DIVERSION

Herefordshire Council has ordered the extinguishment of part of footpath BM12 and the diversion of part of that footpath. Herefordshire Council has also ordered the extinguishment of part of footpath BM13. Maps showing these changes can be seen on the Parish Council noticeboard at Saffrons Garage and under 'Council Documents' on the Parish Website (www.bodenhamparish.org.uk). Any representations or objections must be lodged with Will Steel, Public Rights of Way Manager (will.steel@amey.co.uk) by 9th September.

NEW BRIDLEWAY

The Secretary of State has confirmed an order to add to the public rights of way a bridleway from the C1125 in Bodenham (starting just south of Rowberry Lane) to Preston Wynne. DINMORE SPOUT

The Parish Council has again been notified by the Scientific Officer in the Environmental Health and Trading Standards department at Herefordshire Council that the water at the spring serving Dinmore Spout is not fit to drink. For the scientifically minded, it was found that there were 32 mpn of clostridia perfringens per 100ml of water on 22nd June and 24mpn on 4th July (compared to 8mpn in May). The safe limit is zero per 100ml! Clostridia perfringens is the third most common cause of food poisoning in the UK. Bus Service Update

The recent Council consultation has been completed `vand analysed, and changes to bus services will occur from 23rd October. Our 426 service will be losing the Friday and Saturday evening journeys, but it appears that everything else will be retained. Thanks to the large number of people from Bodenham who took part in the consultation, which undoubtedly helped the retention of most of our service. However there is no room for complacency. This route will be due for re-tendering in the future so it is important that we keep making good use of the bus.

Full details of the consultation and proposed changes to all the bus services in Herefordshire can be found on the Council website. Some of the main findings of the consultation were:

• Top priorities for people are Monday to Friday daytime, Monday to Friday early mornings, and Saturday daytime.

• The main reasons are access to essential services such as health and shopping, and to education and employment. It was also recognised that the bus is a lifeline for people.

A report on the consultation included a map showing the level of responses from different parts of the County, and I am pleased to say that Bodenham shows a high level of response. Thanks again for your support and I will keep you informed of any developments in future Newsletters.
